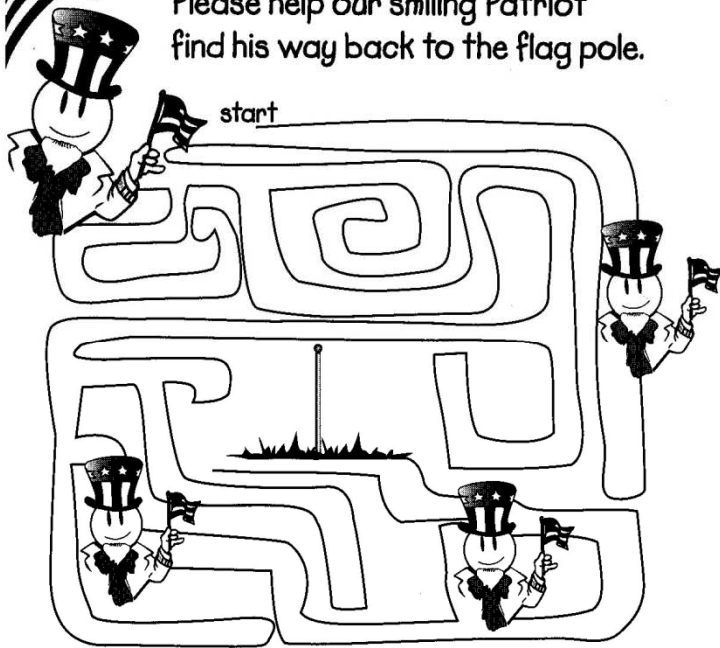

Just as there were 13 original colonies there are 13 words hidden in the puzzle above. How many can you find?

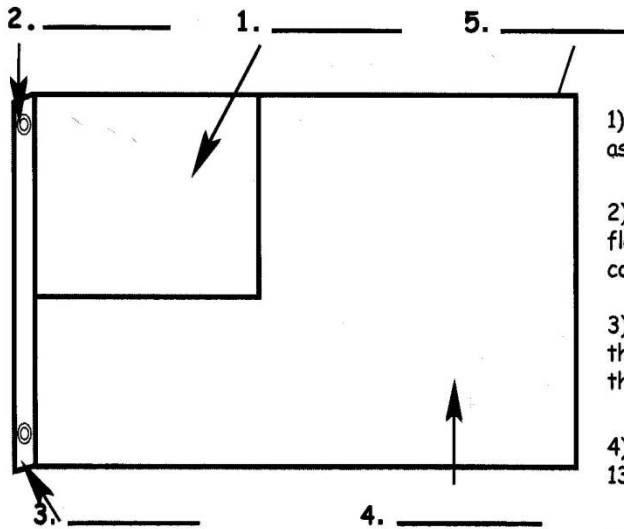

4) GRAND UNION- Hint: This flag symbolized the 13 colonies united under England's rule. d. _____



5) KINGS COLORS- Hint: This flag served as the standard for the United Kingdom and all her colonies. e. _____



6) STAR SPANGLED BANNER- Hint: The US had 15 states when this version of our flag inspired Francis Scott Key to write our national anthem. f. _____



7) BENNINGTON- Hint: Reproductions of this early American flag were very popular during our nation's bicentennial in 1976. g. _____
